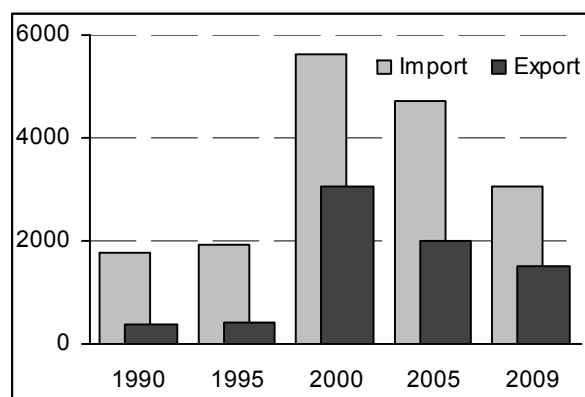

Change of Residence

818 people from the United States took up residence in Hamburg, while 1,320 persons moved from Hamburg to the United States.

Marriages

18 American men married German women, eleven German men married American women.

Education

During the school year 2009/2010, 102 U.S. students attended general schools of education, 18 U.S. students attended vocational schools in Hamburg.

During the winter term 2009/2010, 105 students from the United States of America enrolled in Hamburg colleges, 65 of those at the University of Hamburg.

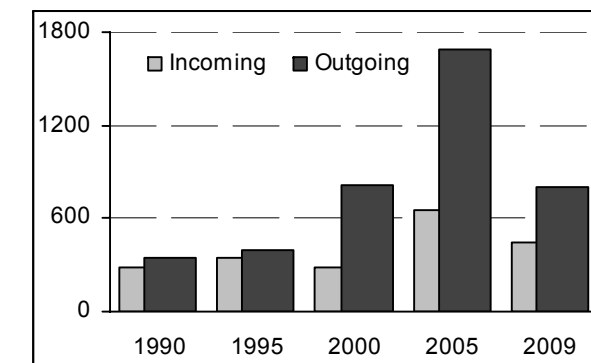
