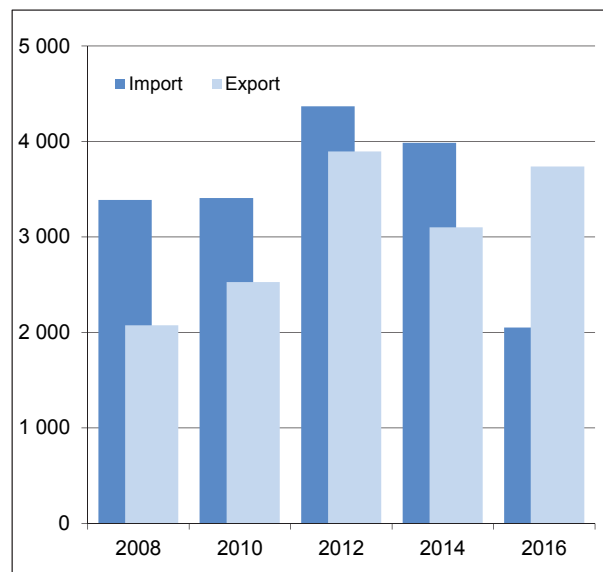

Duration of residence in Germany

65.5 % of all British nationals resident in Hamburg have been living in Germany for at least eight years.

Change of residence (2015)

975 people from Great Britain took up residence in Hamburg, whilst 1,105 people moved from Hamburg to Great Britain.

Marriages (2015)

20 British men married German women, 14 times German men married British women.

Education

During the school year 2016/2017, 134 British pupils attended general schools of education, 22 British nationals attended vocational schools in Hamburg. During the winter term 2015/2016, 105 students from Great Britain enrolled in Hamburg colleges, 61 of those at the University of Hamburg and 11 at the Bucerius Law School Hamburg.

Employment

1,757 British nationals were employed at Hamburg-based companies, paying into social security, i. e. 56.2 per cent of the total number of British nationals aged between 18 and 60 years living in Hamburg.

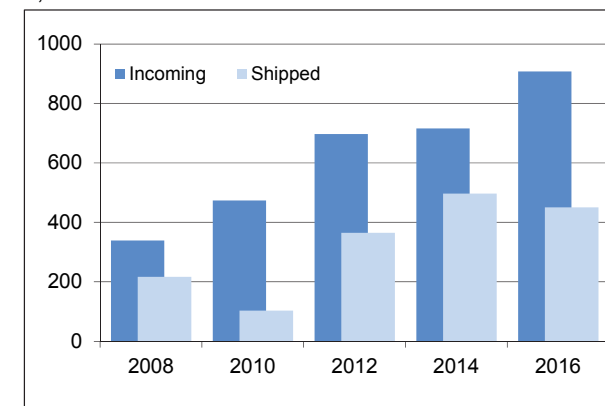
